The European and since 2005 the **World Body Painting Association** was founded in Austria in October 2001. The association began as a result of the yearly World Bodypainting Festival which started in Austria. The WBA focuses on networking of artists and bodypainting interested people and companies all around the world with many different activities, events and education programs.

Even though the goal of the WBA to promote bodypainting as an art form was reached years ago, they connect creative minds to keep pushing limits.

French Awards

The French Award: Brush/Sponge takes place on Saturday, 6th of April 2019.

The French Award: Open Category takes place on Sunday, 7th of April 2019.

Contest Guidelines

The guidelines are provided by WBA, the World Bodypainting Association and are based on the experience of its championships.

- The number of participants is limited in both categories. Early registration is recommended. The confirmation is depending on registration time and portfolio.
- Deadline for registration is the 14th March 2019.
- When registering payment of € 60 is necessary. If you don't show up, the fee will not be refunded. The refund of € 40 (for WBA Members € 50) is only for those who participate in the competition. Registrations are only possible online via www.wb-association.org or via email: office@wb-association.org.
When registering an example photo of the artist's work as well as a portrait photo must be sent by email.
- It is possible to take part in both categories.
- The artist may work with 1 assistant. Any failure will be penalized by disqualification. Note: Models may not paint themselves or the second model as this is counted as a second assistant! No more assistants are allowed for hairstyling etc.

- It's up to the artist how many models they would like to paint.
- Only Bodypainting colours are to be used for any painting on the body. We ask you to please think of the safety of your model!
- Any brand of paint product may be used. Participants have to bring their own working material.
- In the brush/sponge category, only this technique is allowed, no applications, effects or airbrush is allowed. See below the details. In the open category you can mix techniques and decorations.
- All supplies have to be provided by participants themselves.
- The jury consists of three judges.
- You are allowed to prepare the hairstyle of the model before the beginning of the contest.
- **Please note:** No using of any color, basis, make up or attachments before the official start.
- The model must be at least 18 years old.
- The models must agree, by signing a form at the information stall, that the photos and video-films made may be further used.
- The artist must also agree by signing a form at the artist information stall, that the photos and video-films made may be further used.
- The models must be wearing at least a g-string, but otherwise the body can remain unclothed.
- The trade show area can be entered from 08.30 am. All needed passes will be deposit at the entrance to the trade show area.

Specific Regulations

French Bodypainting Award: Category Brush/Sponge

- The bodypainting competition is a classic brush/Sponge. Airbrush, special effects or decoration that is attached to the body are not allowed.
- 20 participants can enter the competition.
- **The theme is: „Poetry, the power of words“**
- The main focus is on the painting.
- The jury judges the work according to:

Quality, technique and ability	1 – 12 points
Interpretation of the theme, idea and originality	1 – 9 points
Composition of the work, overall impression	1 – 9 points

The following is a list of **THINGS ALLOWED** in this category:

- False Fingernails
- False Eyelashes
- Eye fashion lenses
- Shoes coming up not higher than the knee
- Wigs and false hair -to be attached only to the hair area on the head
- Glitter in loose form or spray on form

Anything not included in this list is not to be used and is against the rules.

Here are a few specifications of things **NOT ALLOWED** in this category:

- Crystal diamonds
- Glitter in a glue form or attached with glue
- Anything attached to the skin with any type of glue masks
- Anything attached to the body with string, elastic, or tape
- Other than decorative headwear as specified above.

- 20 participants can enter the competition.
- **The theme is: „Finland – A tale in between nature and innovation“**
- The main focus is on the painting.
- The jury judges the work according to:

Quality, technique and ability	1 – 12 points
Interpretation of the theme, idea and originality	1 – 9 points
Composition of the work, overall impression	1 – 9 points

The following is a list of **THINGS ALLOWED** in this category:

- False Fingernails
- False Eyelashes
- Eye fashion lenses
- Shoes coming up not higher than the knee
- Wigs and false hair -to be attached only to the hair area on the head
- Glitter in loose form or spray on form
- Crystal diamonds
- Glitter in glue form
- Attachment with glue
- Masks, Bold heats and other special effects
